

ABBREVIATIONS

k=knit; p=purl; st(s)=stitch(es); rep=repeat; beg=beginning; tog=together; Tw2=k into front of 2nd st on left hand needle, k first st and slip loops off tog; Tw2B=k into back of 2nd st on left hand needle from behind first st, k first st and slip loops off tog; inc=increase; dec=decrease; patt=pattern; st st=stocking stitch; tbl=through back of loop.

TENSION

4½ sts and 6 rows to 2.5 cm (1 inch) measured over stocking stitch using size 4½ mm (7) needles.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE REQUIRED MEASUREMENTS

SIZES

**61-66-71-76-81 cm
24-26-28-30-32 inch**

BACK

With size 3½ mm (9) needles cast on 70 (74) (78) (82) (86) sts.

1st row: k2 * p2 k2 rep from * to end.

2nd row: p2 * k2 p2 rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows until rib measures 5 cm (2 inches) inc one st in centre of last row [71 (75) (79) (83) (87) sts].

Change to size 4½ mm (7) needles and patt as follows

1st row: p11 (13) (15) (17) (19) Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B k8 p1 k1 p1 k8 Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B p to end.

2nd row: k11 (13) (15) (17) (19) p2 k3 p5 k3 p9 k1 p1 k1 p1 k1 p9 k3 p5 k3 p2 k to end.

Keeping 11 (13) (15) (17) (19) sts each end in reverse st st continue in patt on centre 49 sts.

3rd row: Tw2 p3 m1 (make one st by picking up loop before next st and knitting it tbl) k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B k6 (p1 k1) 3 times p1 k6 Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B.

4th row: p2 k3 p5 k3 p7 (k1 p1) 4 times k1 p7 k3 p5 k3 p2.

5th row: Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B k4 (p1 k1) 5 times p1 k4 Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B.

6th row: p2 k3 p5 k3 p5 (k1 p1) twice k1 p3 (k1 p1) twice k1 p5 k3 p5 k3 p2.

7th row: Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B k2 (p1 k1) twice p1 k5 (p1 k1) twice p1 k2 Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B.

8th row: p2 k3 p5 k3 p3 (k1 p1) twice k1 p7 (k1 p1) twice k1 p3 k3 p5 k3 p2.

9th row: Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B k2 (p1 k1) twice p1 k5 (p1 k1) twice p1 k2 Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B.

10th row: as 6th row.

11th row: Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B k4 (p1 k1) 5 times p1 k4 Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B.

12th row: as 4th row.

13th row: Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B k6 (p1 k1) 3 times p1 k6 Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B.

14th row: as 2nd row.

15th row: Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B k8 p1 k1 p1 k8 Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B.

16th row: p2 k3 p5 k3 p23 k3 p5 k3 p2. These 16 rows form the patt rep them until work measures 20 (24) (28) (32) (37) cm (8 (9½) (11) (12½) (14½) inches) from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Shape raglans

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

3rd row: p1 p2 tog work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

4th row: k1 k2 tog work to last 3 sts k2 tog k1.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until 47 (51) (55) (59) (63) sts remain.

Next row: p1 p2 tog work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

Next row: k2 work to last 2 sts k2.

Rep last 2 rows until 21 (23) (23) (25) (25) sts remain.

Cast off.

POCKET LININGS

(make 2)

With size 4½ mm (7) needles cast on 23 sts and work 9 cm (3½ inches) in st st ending with a p row.

Leave sts on a holder.

LEFT FRONT

* With size 3½ mm (9) needles cast on 30 (30) (34) (34) (38) sts and work 5 cm (2 inches) in rib as given for back inc 1 (3) (1) (3) (1) sts on last row [31 (33) (35) (37) (39) sts].

Change to size 4½ mm (7) needles and patt as follows.

1st row: p4 (5) (6) (7) (8) Tw2B k8 p1 k1 p1 k8 Tw2 p to end.

2nd row: k4 (5) (6) (7) (8) p9 k1 p1 k1 p1 k1 p9 k to end.

Keeping 4 (5) (6) (7) (8) sts each end in reverse st st continue in patt on centre 23 sts.

3rd row: Tw2B k6 (p1 k1) 3 times p1 k6 Tw2.

4th row: p7 (k1 p1) 4 times k1 p7.

5th row: Tw2B k4 (p1 k1) 5 times p1 k4 Tw2.

6th row: p5 (k1 p1) twice k1 p3 (k1 p1) twice k1 p5.

7th row: Tw2B k2 (p1 k1) twice p1 k5 (p1 k1) twice p1 k2 Tw2.

8th row: p3 (k1 p1) twice k1 p7 (k1 p1) twice k1 p3.

9th row: as 7th row.

10th row: as 6th row.

11th row: as 5th row.

12th row: as 4th row.

13th row: as 3rd row.

14th row: as 2nd row.

15th row: as 1st row.

16th row: k4 (5) (6) (7) (8) p23 k to end.

These 16 rows form the patt rep them until work measures 14 cm (5½ inches) from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Place pocket

Next row: p4 (5) (6) (7) (8) place next 23 sts to a holder for pocket top, patt across 23 sts on pocket lining holder p to end. *

Continue until front measures same as back to raglan shaping ending with a wrong side row.

Shape raglan

1st row: cast off 4 sts work to end.

2nd row: work to last 2 sts k2.

3rd row: p1 p2 tog work to end.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until 15 (16) (16) (17) (17) sts remain ending with a right side row.

Shape neck

** Still dec every alt row at raglan edge cast off 5 (5) (5) (6) (6) sts at beg of next row and dec one st at this same edge every following alt row until 4 (3) (3) (3) (3) sts remain.

Dec at raglan only until 2 sts remain.

K2 tog and fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work from * to * on instructions given for left front.

Continue until front measures same as back to raglan shaping ending with a right side row.

Shape raglan

1st row: cast off 4 sts work to end.

2nd row: work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

3rd row: k2 work to end.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until 16 (17) (17) (18) (18) sts remain ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Complete as given from ** on instructions given for left front.

SLEEVES

With size 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ mm (9) needles cast on 26 (30) (30) (34) (34) sts and work 5 cm (2 inches) in rib as given for back inc 3 (3) (3) (1) (5) sts on last row [29 (33) (33) (35) (39) sts].

Change to size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles and patt as follows.

1st row: p7 (9) (9) (10) (12) Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B p to end.

2nd row: k7 (9) (9) (10) (12) p2 k3 p5 k3 p2 k to end.

3rd row: p7 (9) (9) (10) (12) Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B p to end.

4th row: as 2nd row.

Keeping centre 15 sts in patt continue inc one st each end of next and every following 4th (6th) (6th) (7th) (7th) row taking inc sts into reverse st st until 47 (49) (53) (55) (59) sts are on the needle.

Work without further shaping until sleeve measures 24 (28) (33) (38) (41) cm (9 $\frac{1}{2}$) (11) (13) (15) (16) inches) from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Shape top

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

3rd row: p1 p2 tog work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

4th row: k2 work to last 2 sts k2.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until 5 sts remain. Cast off.

COLLAR

With size 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ mm (9) needles cast on 58 (62) (66) (70) (74) sts.

1st row: k2 * p2 k2 rep from * to end.

2nd row: k1 p1 * k2 p2 rep from * to last 4 sts k2 p1 k1.

Rep last 2 rows for 10 cm (4 inches).

Cast off in rib.

POCKET TOPS

With size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles work in rib as given for back across sts at pocket tops dec one st in centre of 1st row. Rib 4 rows.

Cast off in rib.

SIZES

86-92-97-102-107-112 cm

34-36-38-40-42-44 inch

BACK

With size 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ mm (9) needles cast on 90 (94) (98) (102) (106) (110) sts.

1st row: k2 * p2 k2 rep from * to end.

2nd row: p2 * k2 p2 rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows until rib measures 7 cm (2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches) inc one st in centre of last row [91 (95) (99) (103) (107) (111) sts].

Change to size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles and patt.

1st row: p21 (23) (25) (27) (29) (31) Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B k8 p1 k1 p1 k8 Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B p to end.

2nd row: k21 (23) (25) (27) (29) (31) p2 k3 p5 k3 p9 k1 p1 k1 p1 k1 p9 k3 p5 k3 p2 k to end.

Keeping 21 (23) (25) (27) (29) (31) sts each end in reverse st st continue in patt on centre 49 sts as given on back of sizes 61 to 81 cm (24 to 32 inch) until work measures 38 (39) (41) (42) (42) (43) cm (15 (15 $\frac{1}{2}$) (16) (16 $\frac{1}{2}$) (16 $\frac{1}{2}$) (17) inches) from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Shape raglans

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

3rd row: p1 p2 tog work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

4th row: k2 work to last 2 sts k2.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until 31 (33) (33) (35) (35) (37) sts remain.

Cast off.

POCKET LININGS

(make 2)

With size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles cast on 23 sts and work 11 cm (4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches) in st st ending with a p row.

Leave sts on a holder.

LEFT FRONT

* With size 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ mm (9) needles cast on 50 (50) (54) (54) (58) (58) sts and work 7 cm (2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches) in rib as given for back inc 3 (5) (3) (5) (3) (5) sts across last row [53 (55) (57) (59) (61) (63) sts].

Change to size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles and keeping 2 (3) (4) (5) (6) (7) sts each end in reverse st st work the remaining 49 sts in patt as given for back until front measures 19 cm (7 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches) from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Place pocket

Next row: work 15 (16) (17) (18) (19) (20) sts place next 23 sts to a holder for pocket top, patt across 23 sts on pocket lining holder and work to end. *

Continue until front measures same as back to raglan shaping ending with a wrong side row.

Shape raglan

1st row: cast off 5 sts work to end.

2nd row: work to last 2 sts k2.

3rd row: p1 p2 tog work to end.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until 29 (30) (31) (32) (33) (34) sts remain ending with a right side row.

Shape neck

** Still dec every alt row at raglan edge cast off 6 (7) (7) (8) (8) (9) sts at beg of next row and 3 sts every following alt row until 3 (3) (4) (4) (5) (5) sts remain. Dec at raglan only until 2 sts remain. K2 tog and fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work from * to * on instructions given for left front.

Continue until front measures same as back to raglan shaping ending with a right side row.

Shape raglan

1st row: cast off 5 sts work to end.

2nd row: work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

3rd row: k2 work to end.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until 30 (31) (32) (33) (34) (35) sts remain ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Complete as given from ** on instructions given for left front.

SLEEVES

With size 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ mm (9) needles cast on 34 (34) (38) (38) (42) (42) sts and work in rib as given for back for 8 cm (3 inches) inc 3 (5) (3) (5) (3) (5) sts on last row [37 (39) (41) (43) (45) (47) sts].

Change to size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles and patt as follows.

1st row: p11 (12) (13) (14) (15) (16) Tw2 p3 k5 p3 Tw2B p to end.

2nd row: k11 (12) (13) (14) (15) (16) p2 k3 p5 k3 p2 k to end.

3rd row: p11 (12) (13) (14) (15) (16) Tw2 p3 m1 k1 p3 tog k1 m1 p3 Tw2B p to end.

4th row: as 2nd row.

Keeping centre 15 sts in patt continue inc one st each end of next and every following 5th row taking inc sts into reverse st st until 67 (69) (73) (75) (79) (81) sts are on the needle.

Work without further shaping until sleeve measures 43 (43) (46) (46) (48) (48) cm (17 (17) (18) (18) (19) (19) inches) from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Shape top

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

3rd row: p1 p2 tog work to last 3 sts p2 tog p1.

4th row: k2 work to last 2 sts k2.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until 7 sts remain.

Cast off.

COLLAR

With size 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ mm (9) needles cast on 78 (82) (86) (86) (90) (94) sts.

1st row: k2 * p2 k2 rep from * to end.

2nd row: k1 p1 * k2 p2 rep from * to last 4 sts k2 p1 k1.

Rep last 2 rows for 13 cm (5 inches).

Cast off in rib.

POCKET TOPS

With size 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (7) needles work in rib as given for back across sts on holders at pocket tops dec one st in centre of 1st row.

Rib 6 rows.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Press pieces lightly with a warm iron and damp cloth using a dry cloth for synthetic yarns.

Join raglan, side and sleeve seams.

Work a row of double crochet up each front edge to neaten. Sew in zip fastener and attach collar.

Press seams.

MACHINE WASHABLE

Argyll Ferntex Aran Type 7 8 9 10 11 12 12 14 15 16 17 balls

1 pair each size 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ and 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (9 and 7) needles

31 (36) (41) (46) (51) (51) (56) (56) (61) (61) (61) cm (12 (14) (16) (18) (20) (20) (22) (22) (24) (24) (24) inch) open end zip fastener. Stitch holders. Medium size crochet hook

Note: When using FERNTEx press with a COOL iron and DRY cloth
